A research analysis carried out to assess the funds raised by the InvestHorizon Accelerator companies that attended the 1st – 3rd cohort, accelerated between May 2019 to June 2020, shows:

- €53+ million Euro equity raised in 2019 and 2020. *
- 33 deals were closed. *
- 25% of the SMEs reached their series A, with an average of 2.3 million. *
